GOD IS POLITICAL

Most pastors in America follow the example of scripture as best they can. As such, they aspire to be more like Jesus. However, it is easy to agree with certain parts of the Bible and be oblivious to others that are outlined in the scriptures. I ask the ministers in America to be more like Christ, not just in character but in the exercise of public ministry. Jesus was very outspoken about the evils in society. He spoke with great boldness to the leaders who have influence. In that sense, He was very political. We should be like Him in boldness, courage and faith, as well as in compassion and gentleness. The Bible tells us ministers to warn the people of approaching danger. If we do not do this, the blood of the people is on our heads. Right now, America is in danger. The sword is coming, and pastors should warn their congregations. Look at these verses; ***"When I bring the sword against the land, and the people choose one of their men and make him their watchman, and he sees the sword coming against the land and blows the trumpet to warn the people, then if anyone hears the trumpet but does not take warning and the sword comes and takes his life, his blood will be on his own head... But if the watchman sees the sword coming but does not blow the trumpet to warn the people and the sword comes and takes the life of one of them....I will hold the watchman accountable for his blood."* Eze. 33:2-6**

THE JOHNSON LAW

In my opinion, the Johnson Law is unconstitutional. The First Amendment grants freedom of religion and freedom of speech. The Johnson Law contradicts that, and is also not biblical. If anyone should be free to give direction to people, it is the pastor. The early apostles preached what God instructed them to preach. ***"Then Jesus said to the crowds... 'The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. So you must obey them... But do not do what they do.'"* Mt. 23:1-2**

Jesus called out the evil leaders of Israel before the crowds. He slammed the Pharisees for their evil ways. The list of accusations is so long it takes 37 verses of the Bible.

Jesus spoke aggressively against the political leaders of His day. If we did not know that Jesus was speaking, we would think that the speaker is rough and rude, and far too bold. But it was in fact Jesus who preached this sermon.

The "Jesus List" is not politically correct. Nevertheless, He is our example, and all ministers must follow His lead. All of the following was taken from one sermon that Jesus preached.

Jesus Exposed the Pharisees

Jesus said:

- They don't practice what they preach.
- They put heavy loads on others that they aren't willing to bear.

- Everything they do is done for men to see.
- They show off to draw attention to themselves.
- Jesus calls them Hypocrites seven times.
- They shut the door to God's kingdom in men's faces.
- They refuse to enter the kingdom of God, themselves.
- They go to great lengths to take converts and make them sons of Hell.
- They are blind guides leading the blind.
- They are full of greed.
- They are self indulging.
- They are whitewashed tombs.
- They are full of dead men's bones.
- They paint a good picture outside, but inside they are full of wickedness.
- Their forefathers were murderers.
- They are murderers.
- They are snakes.
- They are abusers of innocent people.
- They are guilty of shedding innocent blood.
- They adamantly refuse to receive the grace of God.

JESUS THE LION

These 20 accusations would be slanderous if they weren't true. Jesus declared them in a public place. That is spiritual, political fervor.

Most importantly, it shows us that Jesus held nothing back.

GOD HATES SOME THINGS

God is political, and as such, He hates some things because they are evil.

"There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to Him:

(1) Haughty eyes,

(2) A lying tongue,

(3) Hands that shed innocent blood,

(4) A heart that devises wicked schemes,

(5) Feet that are quick to rush into evil,

(6) A false witness who pours out lies,

(7) A person who stirs up conflict in the community." Pro 6:16-19

God hates these seven things. As such, I hate some things. I hate racism, the KKK, fake news, abortionists, child abuse, family-destroyers, corrupt politicians, violence, arrogant pride, murderers, witchcraft, demons, communistic socialism and the anti-church, anti-Christ spirit.
